President's Report - Jill Sanfellippo

- Summerfest Opportunity
 - o Jill did some research and is waiting for clarification from Summerfest people
 - A lot of stipulations to consider
 - May October time frame
 - Penalties for volunteers not showing or slight revenue discrepancies
 - Incoming freshman and 8th grade classes likely will have same volunteer make-up busy parents and same core group likely does most of volunteering
 - Would be a huge commitment for someone to oversee
 - o Around \$6,600 in revenue to make up *Actually \$11,630.35 will need to be made up

- Concessions reconciliation should be final \$15,000 in revenue

Corresponding Secretary Report – Dianne Crowley

- St. Patrick's Day Parade Saturday, March 9, 3:30pm
 - Creating an event for social media
 - Sponsored by Magoos ask about getting dedicated space inside for Band parents to hang out, any signage we have could be put outside
 - Will be last formal march before graduation are we able to organize an official senior photo? Noah will mention to his dad
 - Senior photo typically taken at May concert to assure everyone is there
 - Have not yet had an event with all seniors present but photo from State was posted to Instagram

- Seniors have been recognized in past at final football game, May concert and Band Banquet
- Recommendation to keep same as prior years
- Lato will ask for senior photos in March to post on social media
- o Confirm that Magoos will be providing buses
- Banquet Alioto's
 - Recommend sticking with Alioto's as they are easy to work with, have adequate accommodations and are reasonably priced
 - o Same space and menu as last year?
 - o Seniors will again be free, others \$17 and can use Square through website
 - A number of conflicting events to work around between Chorus, Orchestra, Spring play, Girls
 Soccer, etc
 - Consider Monday, May 13 / Monday, May 20 / Tuesday, May 21 check with Ms. Lato to finalize date
 - Alioto's is closed on Mondays 21st would be only date that could work
 - If 21st is not available at Alioto's, will need to seek new venue
 - Anything earlier would be too close to fundraiser pick-up and band concert
 - o Noah will check with his dad as to whether we can offer a photo booth again
 - Not necessary can have a selfie spot to set up ourselves
- Would be nice to have an end of year gathering of sorts for Board members and band parents
- Board members available and willing to support as Dianne takes care of herself and some health concerns

Project Chairperson's Report – Tom Hoffer

- Will complete his position as of June 30
- Finalizing manual to pass on to new Coordinators
- No longer a standing contract for Hart will need to have go-ahead from the East and Marquette Athletic Departments since they are renters through Wauwatosa – would be good to have confirmation by May 1
 - Hart has been confirmed with East and Marquette Athletics
 - o Happened in January once football schedules were finalized
 - Meg has dates for volunteer outreach
- Coolers had been moved out due to renovations
- Tom given go-ahead to throw out expired inventory and donate the rest to Hope House; water will come back to school for band use

Brewers Coordinator's Report - Lisa Hollander
